

# United Nations SDG Questions Creation Contest



## Question Scoring Criteria

Up to **10 points** can be awarded to a question, according to the following criteria and weightings:

Criteria	Weighting	A higher score can be awarded if the question ...
<b>Relevance and accuracy (R)</b>	6 points	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Is directly related to the selected SDG</li> <li>Is accurate in terms of the data and information presented (in the question text, the correct answer and the explanation to the correct answer)</li> <li>Is with citations of the sources of data/information</li> </ul>
<b>Creativity (C)</b>	3 points	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Is challenging to answer. For example, a person cannot answer the question immediately after reading it, or after a quick search on the Web</li> <li>Promotes deeper thinking of the SDG concerned</li> </ul>
<b>Language (L)</b>	1 point	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Is free from spelling and grammatical errors</li> </ul>
<b>Total (R+C+L):</b>	<b>10 points</b>	

For an entrant submitting multiple questions, his/her score will be the sum of the scores of all the valid questions submitted.
